**THE LATE MR WILLIAM OGILVIE**  
 A RETIRED Elgin coal merchant, Mr William Ogilvie, died suddenly at his home, Gowabrae, Fortheath Avenue, Elgin, on Saturday.  
 A native of Newmill, Keith, Mr Ogilvie was eighty-five and retired in 1938.  
 In his youth he was a pioneer of cycling in the North-east and was a noted "penny-farthing" racing cyclist. He took part in races between Inverness and Aberdeen and held medals.  
 Mr Ogilvie was also interested in football and cricket and played golf.  
 He is survived by one daughter, Dr Beatrice M. Ogilvie, Elgin.

 Through marriage - M<sup>rs</sup> Annie Ogilvie m.s. Fargher. was the  
 Grand-Aunt of J<sup>r</sup> Beatrix Ogilvie.

 William Anderson & James Scott parents of the said Eliper Anderson the former  
 died 1840 aged 88 & the latter died 1843 aged 86, in affectionate remembrance  
 of Alexander Ogilvie son of Joseph Ogilvie fieur, Newmill died at Elgin  
 December 1894. aged 79 his wife Jane Ross died April 1891 aged 76  
 Their children Mary died February 1895 aged 39. also Isabella died
