Dear Rev. Farquhar:

Thank you for your letter and information. I have redrawn your chart no. 73, and will enclose a copy for you. I searched for some West Indies connection, and have one family that came from the Kincardine area of Scotland to Jamaica. They were born about 1750-1776, but no Alexander is mentioned. There was a Mary, a Francis, an Elizabeth, Dr. George, who died in Jamaica, and a Jean. His family went to U.S.A. around Pottsville, Pa. So I'm quite sure that there isn't any connection, but I may find one yet in some family.

I have some Ordnance maps of Scotland that show every house and farm. The names, Coldhouse, Dackland, and Mill O'Birnie are no doubt the names of farms. Unfortuneately, I do not have the Elgin area. They are on map no. 27 or 28. I have written to find out how to obtain these sheets, and how much they are.

As for the Ludovick Farquhar, I do not have anything in my records on this name. My records of England are not as complete as Scotland, as I found it much more difficult to access the records in London than in Edinburgh.

There are quite a few blanks on Dates, Names, and Place of Birth, and Place of Death on this DWG 73 that maybe you could help me fill in.

Hoping to hear from you soon. We may take a trip to Nova Scotia, P.E.I. and Newfoundland this summer, probably in July.
