Dear Alexander's James,

When you both were in Atlanta I told you that I would send out Farquhar history information to you.

This is taken from The Records of Invercauld accounts of the origin & growth of the Clan Farquhar.

"Gaw of Rothimerchus, lineally descended from the most ancient Thanes & Earls of Fife, had a son called Farquhar, who settled in the braes of Mar. His sons, as was the custom of these early times, were called Farquharsons or sons of Farquhar; & hence, from the surname of the family Farquhar, all the Farquharsons in Scotland are

descended.'

Farquharson of Invercauld
the predecessor of this Family,
is descended from McDuff,
Thane of Fife, being descended
from Shaw McDuffs third
son, who went North.

*note: 2nd son of Constantine,
3rd earl of Fife."

Farquhar, son of Shaw of
Rathiemurchus, lived in the
reign of King Robert II (1370-1390)
& King Robert III (1390-1406).
He was 2nd of 7 sons of John
Shaw (alias John with the Buck
Tooth).

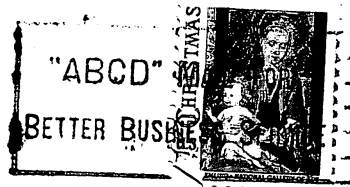
This goes on & on - about
